

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(Horton Road and Hatters Lane, Chipping Sodbury) (Temporary Prohibition of use by
Vehicles and Foot Passengers) Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

This order is required in connection with the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon sewer connection works and will be operative from the 7 May 2019 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of **5 weeks** duration.

Alternative route - Hatters Lane, Gorlands Road, Horse Street, Smarts Green Roundabout, St Johns Way and vice versa

Schedule – Horton Road from St Johns Way to Hatters Lane. Hatters Lane from Horton Road southwards for 70m.
