

**SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL**  
**(Heron Way, Chipping Sodbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles)**  
**Order 2022**

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles that length of Heron Way which extends from its junction with A432 to its junction with Mallard Close.

This order is required for the following reason: in connection with junction signalisation works. The order will be operative from 6 June 2022 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of **12 weeks** duration.
